



Dear Parents/Carers,

I sincerely hope this letter finds you and your family safe and well.

As you know, the government announced recently that the country's schools needed to start the planning to reopen for some year groups from Monday 1st June. We will know for definite on Thursday 28th May if the government still deem these plans safe enough to proceed with. We have been working very hard on the Academy opening plans to ensure the safe return for our children and the staff. With this in mind, Monday 1st June will be an Inset day to ensure that we have all the final arrangements in place. The Academy will therefore, open to those children whose parents have requested a place in the key year groups on Tuesday 2nd June. Key worker children will still have access to the Academy on Monday 1st June.

What happens next?

- Children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6
Before the end of the week, arrangements will be shared with parents / carers of children who have requested a place for children in these year groups.
- Key worker children
In the same way that we have ensured continuous provision since schools closed in March, children of key workers will keep their place at the Academy. This is regardless of the year group that these children belong to. If your child has been attending throughout this time, those arrangements will continue. This will be confirmed to you before the end of the week.
- Children who are not returning to the Academy yet
We very much look forward to welcoming our whole community back to the Academy as and when the government says we can. Until that time, we have made additional arrangements to supplement the 'at home' curriculum that our children have access to. Further communication will be shared in due course with further details of the support available to you in delivering this.

As the next few weeks roll out, we will learn more about this developing situation and will be in regular contact about next steps.
